HIGHLIGHTS

Panama

Over \$48,000 of funding has been raised for 12 water and sanitation projects.

Dominican Republic

58 community organizations and schools have increased their capacity in the education sector.

Ghana

More than 2,200 local community members have participated in the design and implementation of 14 education projects.

Moldova

More than 6,600 people have received an indirect benefit due to grant projects.

Morocco

Over \$19,000 in local community contributions have combined with over \$49,000 in funding to benefit youth development projects.

Cambodia

More than 1,700 girls and young women have participated in 29 Let Girls Learn projects.

Lesotho

Over \$33,000 of funding has been raised for 19 education projects.

Philippines

Over \$42,000 in funding has been raised for 18 projects across 8 different primary sectors, including Education, Environment, Gender, Youth, and Economic Development.
