



The United States Peace Corps/Madagascar is recruiting for the following position:

**1- EIGHT (8) TEMPORARY LANGUAGE AND CROSS-CULTURAL FACILITATOR (LCF)**

The position is based at the Peace Corps Training Center, in Mantsoa, and is a short time contract (13 weeks).

The duties of the LCF include, but are not limited to:

- Conduct Malagasy language training classes with small groups of trainees
- Participate in the preparation of language training materials or resources under the supervision of the Language Coordinator
- Conduct formal sessions and provide ongoing informal instruction and advice to Trainees regarding cultural adaptation and culturally appropriate behavior
- Actively participate in staff language training
- Interact with trainees outside of the classroom setting
- Serve as the cultural model and guide for Trainees within their communities
- Establish and maintain a healthy, productive team spirit among the language staff and between support staff and Volunteer trainers
- Install the new Volunteers at their permanent sites; and train their community-based tutor as needed

**Required Qualifications:**

- Completion of secondary school (Minimum BACC)
- Fluency in English, French and Malagasy
- Master at least one of the following dialects: Betsileo, Betsimisaraka, Antambahoaka, Antemoro and Antefasy.
- Previous experience working in a cross-cultural setting
- Experience in designing, facilitating and conducting training sessions
- Good inter-personal teamwork and communication skills
- Competency in Microsoft Office computer applications
