


Guinea


- Guinea Volunteers reported 5 victimizations in 2014.
- The most commonly reported crime classification by Guinea Volunteers is burglary.
- The most common serious crime classification reported by Guinea Volunteers is robbery.
- 86.7% of all reported victimizations resulted in no physical injury to the Volunteer.
- 36.7% of all reported victimizations occurred outside of the Volunteer's assigned site.
- 53.3% of all reported victimizations occurred at volunteer residence.
- 23.3% of all reported victimizations occurred in a capital city.
- 76.7% of Volunteer reported victims were female and 23.3% were male.

Incidence Rate of Reported Victimizations, Guinea, Africa Region, and Peace Corps Global, 2014




*Rate for sexual assaults is reported per 100 female Volunteer/Trainee years.
