


- Jordan Volunteers reported 9 victimizations in 2014.
- The most commonly reported crime classification by Jordan Volunteers is physical assault.
- The most common serious crime classification reported by Jordan Volunteers is aggravated sexual assault.
- 98.8% of all reported victimizations resulted in no physical injury to the Volunteer.
- 26.5% of all reported victimizations occurred outside of the Volunteer’s assigned site.
- 43.4% of all reported victimizations occurred in a public area, most often on a street or in a square.
- 10.8% of all reported victimizations occurred in a capital city.
- 74.7% of Volunteer reported victims were female and 25.3% were male.

Incidence Rate of Reported Victimization, Jordan, EMA Region, and Peace Corps Global, 2014




*Rate for sexual assaults is reported per 100 female Volunteer/Trainee years.
