


- Kenya Volunteers reported 9 victimizations in 2014.
- The most commonly reported crime classification by Kenya Volunteers is theft.
- The most common serious crime classification reported by Kenya Volunteers is robbery.
- 95.6% of all reported victimizations resulted in no physical injury to the Volunteer.
- 58.4% of all reported victimizations occurred outside of the Volunteer's assigned site.
- 33.6% of all reported victimizations occurred at the Volunteer residence.
- 23% of all reported victimizations occurred in a capital city.
- 72.6% of Volunteer reported victims were female and 27.4% were male.

Incidence Rate of Reported Victimizations, Kenya, Africa Region, and Peace Corps Global, 2014




*Rate for sexual assaults is reported per 100 female Volunteer/Trainee years.
