



Peace Corps Map Suggested Activities

Suggestion: Use with the Peace Corps map in the Third Goal Activity Kit. Make copies of the map and this exercise sheet as handouts. Have youths work in small groups of 4-5 to solve and report out to larger group and discuss. You could create and provide a fact sheet of your preferred Peace Corps country to supplement this activity. Use one or all of these recommended activities.

Part 1:

Pick a Peace Corps country. By looking at the map, what do you know about the country's topography?

- Is it mostly grassland? Mountain? Arid areas? Landlocked? Surrounded by ocean? Have rivers running through it?
- How do you think the people live in these areas?
- What would they do for a living?
- What types of transportation would they have?
- What types of crops would they have access to?
- What kinds of animals live in this area?

Part 2:

Pick a Peace Corps country. What kinds of Volunteers would this country benefit from and why?

- Agriculture Volunteers
- Education, Youth Outreach, and Community Development Volunteers
- Environment Volunteers
- Health Volunteers
- HIV/AIDS Volunteers
- Information and Communications Technology (ICT) Volunteers
