

Goal: Demonstrate an understanding of the Peace Corps

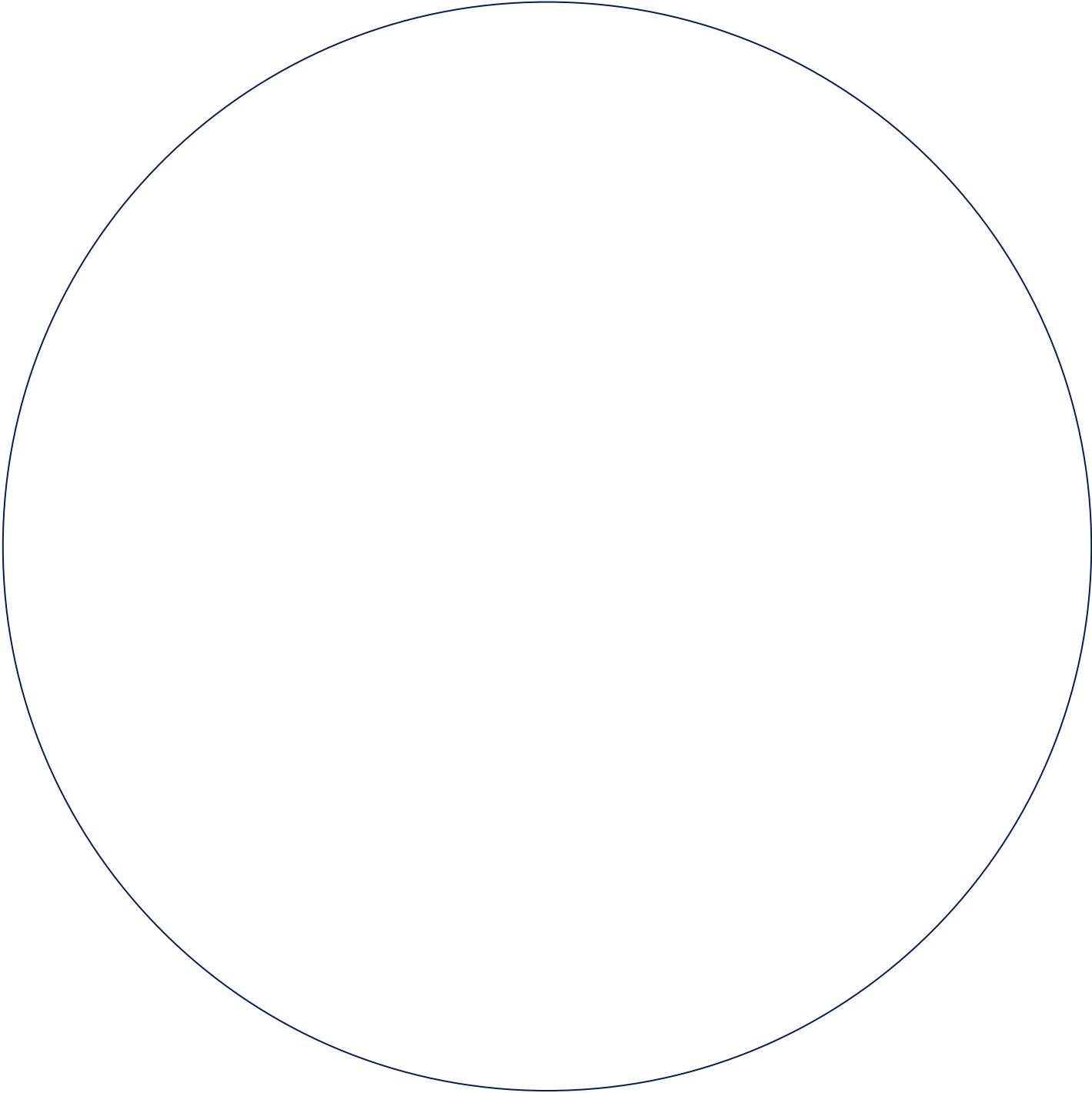
We will write down what we know, want to know, and have learned about the Peace Corps during this unit. This is your capture sheet, so you will be prepared to contribute to the class KWL chart.
