




The Education Project

About us

Peace Corps is a Volunteer agency of the United States Government. It was established in 1961 by President John F. Kennedy to promote world peace and friendship. At the request of the Government of Uganda, Peace Corps began operating in Uganda in 1964. Peace Corps' goals are to help Ugandans meet their need for trained men and women, enable Ugandans to have a better understanding of American culture and people, and teach Americans about Ugandans by sharing their culture.

Volunteers support Ugandan teachers to enhance pupils' literacy levels through: implementing

evidence-based literacy instructionmethods to ensure effective teaching practices; creating and utilizing teaching and learning materials that are tailored to provide high-quality instruction and cater to diverse learning needs; involving parents and community members actively in their children's learning process to foster a supportive and collaborative educational environment; and cultivating a reading culture within the community by organizing events, activities, and initiatives that promote the joy and importance of reading among both children and adults.

Pupils attain literacy skills to improve learning outcomes.

OBJECTIVES



Increase the capacity of teachers in literacy and general (including positive classroom culture and student centered teaching techniques) teaching skills.
