

Post	Region	Will Post accept shorter terms of service?	Notes
Armenia	EMA	Yes	TEFL: must arrive with cohort in March, and must serve a minimum of 15 months (March 2026 – May 2027) YD: must serve a minimum of 12 months
Belize	IAP	Yes	All transfers must be willing to serve a minimum of 12 months. Post prefers transfers who come from YD or ED programs--or who bring experience in those sectors but is open to Volunteers from all sectors. For Volunteers with no relevant education, training or experience in YD or EDU, Post would ask them to participate in PST and serve for 15 months (12 months of service + 3 months of PST). For Volunteers who served in a different sector but have experience that is relevant to an aspect of our project, Post is able to develop custom assignments and accept them off cycle. There is no degree requirement for transfers into the YD program. Transfers into the ED sector must have one of the following: a college degree in education; or have completed two years of service in an education/literacy assignment plus a college degree in any field.
Benin	AF	Yes	Transfer must be intermediate high in French. Education PCV must arrive in June, September or January. Agriculture can be more flexible. Education transfers must have prior teaching experience. PCVs can serve for one year.
Cambodia	EMA	Yes	Must have Bachelor's Degree for teaching assignment, and complete PST. Botswana is happy to accept PCVs for just one year of service
Cameroon	AF	Yes	Must be Intermediate low/mid in French. Education transfers must arrive in December/January. Cameroon is happy to accept PCVs for one year of service
Colombia	IAP	Yes	High Spanish level required. Shorter term of service should be between 7-15 months.
Costa Rica	IAP	Yes	<u>Sector Specific Guidance</u> Education: All EDU transfers must attend PST. Bachelor's degree required. Spanish required: 4 years of High School w/in the past 8 years; 2 semesters elementary level (e.g., through 102) in the past 6 years; CLEP Score 50-62; ACTFL OPI Score Novice High or Intermediate Low CED: They may serve 1-year or 2 years. Spanish level required: Intermediate-Low; Intermediate-High preferred YD: Volunteers who are not currently serving YD Volunteers must attend PST on-cycle. Spanish required: Intermediate-Low; Intermediate-High preferred
Dominican Republic	IAP	Yes	Post's preference is minimum one year but will accept 10-11 months if extension fully aligns with one academic year (August-June).
Eastern Caribbean	IAP	Yes	Post is open to 1-2 year transfers and not shorter than 1 year as we would like to maintain supporting during 1 full school year.
Ecuador	IAP	Yes	High Spanish level required or else they must attend PST. Shorter term of service should be between 12-15 months.
El Salvador	IAP	Yes	Shorter term of service must be at least one year. Off-cycle inputs can only be received between February-June or November-December. Must have served in YD or CED. Intermediate High Spanish level required.
Eswatini	AF	Yes	PC/Eswatini can accommodate shorter terms of service for third year transfer volunteers. If transfer PCVs are interested in our community-based sector projects and they are willing to re-do PST we are open to 12-15 month transfers. If English is the language required for the position, we are also open to a shorter term of service, but no less than 6 months.
Georgia	EMA	Yes	Post can accept 1 or 2 year PCV transfers, provided they participate in PST. Post can accept PCR transfers for 10-12 months based on availability of partners and provided PCVs meet minimum qualifications. PCR transfers must participate in September orientation. Post can accept off-cycle PCVs with either Armenian (1 V) or Azerbaijani and/or Turkish language skills (1 V) for specific EDU placements in Armenian or Azerbaijani ethnic communities. These Vs would require intermediate low (B1) level language abilities upon arrival. Post is open to accept off-cycle EDU Vs with strong technical skills (two years of experience teaching or co-teaching English in the classroom). The ideal off-cycle PCV input time would be September to coincide with PCR intake.
Ghana	AF	Yes	Will accept transfers twice per year. Once in January. Once in August/September. Don't have to have been health, ag or education PCV in previous service. Post is happy to accept 1 year of service.
Guatemala	IAP	Yes	12 months minimum; Post prefers to align timing with 1) other intakes, or 2) EIST for like programs (Jan for YD and July for AG and HE). Those who wish to bypass PST must have Advanced Low or higher Spanish level, confirmed by an LPI.

Guinea	AF	Yes	Post currently has PC Response positions for English teachers at partner universities. These positions are 12-month assignments which could also be filled by 3rd Year PCV (extension/transfer). Shorter terms of service would not work as well for Public Health or Agriculture.
Indonesia	EMA	Yes	Post is open to receiving 1-year transfers, but they must complete PST, making the total commitment approximately 15 months. Since this type of service is not contemplated in the MoU, we will need to work with the Government for approval, but we are optimistic that they will approve.

Kosovo	EMA	Yes	Transfers must complete PST but can serve for a minimum of 15 months (12 months + 3 months PST)
Kyrgyz Republic	EMA	Yes	Will accept transfers intending to serve 12-18 months
Lesotho	AF	Yes	
Liberia	AF	Yes	Liberia is flexible and will take Transfer Volunteers for less than 27 months.
Madagascar	AF	Yes	All sectors and degrees welcomed. No language requirements as long as PCV is willing to learn language for at least 2-3 weeks in Tana, then have on-going tutoring at site.
Malawi	AF	Yes	Malawi is happy to accept one year of service
Mexico	IAP	Yes	All transfers must arrive with an incoming cohort (August) and complete PST. Only PCVs transferring into the TEFL program may complete shorter terms of service of 16 months total (PST plus 13 months with a new COS date in December of the following year). If PCVs hoping to transfer into the TEFL program are not currently serving in a TEFL program in another country, Post would want to see some professional or academic experience that shows a connection to the education field. PCVs transferring into the Environment program must serve a full 27-month term.
Mongolia	EMA	Yes	Must have Bachelor's Degree for teaching assignment, and complete PST. Mongolia will accept transfers serving for one year but prefers previous classroom teaching experience.
Morocco	EMA	Yes	PST is required for cultural integration. Post not able to accept off-cycle transfers but will accept transfers serving for only one year
Namibia	AF	Yes	Best transfer timing: mid-January to mid-July; one date during PST (e.g., mid-October). Transfers must serve a minimum of 10 months
Nepal	EMA	Yes	PST is required because of language and training requirements and PCV must serve a minimum of 15 months
Panama	IAP	Yes	Off-cycle inputs must already speak Spanish and have served in AG, YD, or ENV; 1-year Transfers who do not meet the language requirement and/or served in a different sector cannot do an off-cycle input.
Paraguay	IAP	Yes	Minimum length of service is 6 months; ideally a PCV would extend for 9-12 months; PCVs must have Advanced Low Spanish
Peru	IAP	Yes	Post prefers candidates to serve for 2 years, especially if the candidate does not have advanced Spanish, but they will consider shorter terms of service
Philippines	EMA	Yes	2-year and PCR inputs are aligned, so transfers into either program would enter with on-cycle cohorts and attend PST or Response training. 1 year of service is welcome with PST participation
Samoa	IAP	Yes	
Sierra Leone	AF	Yes	Sierra Leone will accept transfer serving only 15 months for 2-year programs (attending PST), 12 months for transfers not attending PST, and 6-12 months for Response. To bypass PST, Krio is required.
Tanzania	AF	Yes	Tanzania is happy to accept transfers serving for one additional year
Thailand	EMA	Yes	No off-cycle inputs. Transfer must enter on-cycle and attend PST. Post is able to accept 1-year or 2-year transfers.
The Gambia	AF	Yes	The Gambia is happy to accept Volunteers transferring for one additional year
Timor-Leste	EMA	Yes	Post would consider 18-month placements for ED Volunteers (PST + 15 month). This would allow PCVs to complete a year of teaching after their initial few months at site.
Togo	AF	Yes	French is the language requirement, and we can conduct a virtual LPI to verify. PCV must serve a minimum of 6 months
