

POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT Language and Cultural Facilitator (LCF Serer Sine)

POSITION STATUS: Part-time (intermittent) with maximum of 30 weeks/year.

LOCATION: Thies, Senegal

The United States Peace Corps in Senegal seeks a qualified individual to fill the intermittent position of **Language** and **Cultural Facilitator** (**LCF**) **Serer Sine**. The position is based in Thies and reports directly to the Language Coordinator.

The Language and Cultural Facilitator (LCF) implements the pre-service and in-service competency-based language curriculum by conducting small classes for Peace Corps trainees. As needed, the LCF provides training in languages other than French (e.g.: Wolof, Pulaar, Serer, and other local languages) to Peace Corps trainees and volunteers. The Language and Cultural Facilitator (LCF) serves as a facilitator, group member, and informant in intercultural training sessions as well as in field trips and resource family feedback sessions. S/he also assists with other training sessions, as necessary.

The ideal candidate must have a High School diploma (Baccalaureate), with a minimum of two years' experience as a language teacher, preferably in a multi-cultural setting.

Interested candidates must have the following qualifications:

- **A. Education:** High school diploma (Baccalaureate)
- **B.** Work Experience: At least 2 years' experience as a language teacher, preferably in a multi-cultural setting.
- **C.** Languages: Good command of English- Level 2 and above. Speak French, and Serer Sine as national language, candidates will be tested.
- **D.** Computer skills: Proficiency using Microsoft Office applications and working on a computer network candidates will be tested.
- **E.** Other: Prior experience interacting and/or working with people of different and diverse backgrounds. Be able to follow instructions and be reliable in attendance and performance.

Interested and qualified applicants for the position should submit the following:

- 1. Letter of interest/motivation, <u>in English</u>, addressing your experience and suitability for the position.
- 2. CV in English with three professional references.
- 3. Certified copy of school diplomas.
- 4. Certified copy of identity card or certificate of nationality.
