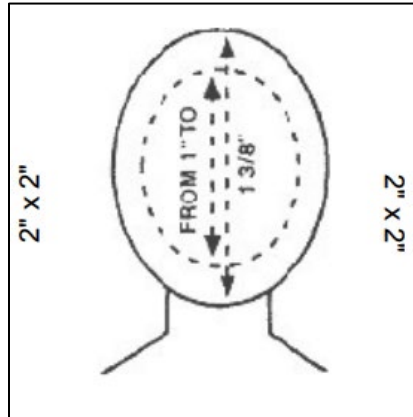

IV. Minors

The definitive admission into México is subject to the authorization of immigration and sanitary authorities at the point of entry, who may at any given time verify, the requirements established in any applicable legal dispositions.
