I was also able to meet with potential employers from the government and private sector and the amount of interviews and offers I received from that fair was incredible. I was able to utilize my NCE (noncompetitive eligibility) status and my transition back into a career has been seamless. NCE status is something not a lot of volunteers know about and they should.
