WebQuest: Improving Food Security

What is food security?

Think of a way that each factor listed below could potentially impact food security, including the availability of food, people's access to food, or people's nutrition or food utilization.

Factor	Possible example	Possible effects on food security
Political strife	<i>Armed conflict prevents farmers from working</i>	<i>Availability:</i> Locally produced foods may not be present for people to eat <i>Access:</i> Farming families will have less money to purchase food <i>Utilization:</i> People may not get the variety of foods they need
